

# Base Maintenance Family of Systems (BMx FoS)



- **Description of Program/Current State:** Considering consolidating two current contracts into a single contract; Acquisition Strategy TBD. The BMx FoS consists of four primary programs: Field Maintenance Command and Control (FMxC2), Facilities and Equipment Maintenance (FEM), Integrated Maintenance Data System – Central Data Base (IMDS CDB), and PMEL Automated Management System (PAMS). These systems are hosted on Prem and in the Cloud. With a range of programming languages; C#, Perl, Python, Cobol, Java, .NET, Bicep, and SQLex.
- **Current/Anticipated Scope of work:** Encompasses full range of Technical and Functional Analysis services required for the life cycle management of the BMx FoS. Contractor shall be responsible for all activities related to agile development, enhancement, sustainment, and operational support. Sustainment activities include corrective, perfective, adaptive, preventive, and predictive maintenance for all systems and applications. The contractor shall provide services that evolve in response to needs established by the Air Staff, the Maintenance Portfolio Manager, and other government stakeholders to consolidate and modernize USAF logistics systems
- **Anticipated Acquisition Strategy and Dollar Value:** Competitive SBEAS; \$59M
- **Anticipated Contact Need Date:** 30 Jan 27
- **Anticipated Priorities/Considerations:** Migration to Cloud, Code Enhancements/Modernization

# Integrated Logistics Systems – Supply (ILS-S)



- **Description of Program/Current State:** ILS-S provides standard automated processes that enable base level activities to perform supply/accounting business in terms of management of orders, issues, turn-ins, shipments and disposal actions. ILS-S also performs base level asset visibility, including receipt, stock, store, and inventory accountability. ILS-S supports Active Duty, Guard and Reserve Force; available 365x24x7 with 18,000 users at 252 sites; 46 interfaces. ILS-S current status is green across the board regarding Budget, Cost and Performance.
- **Current/Anticipated Scope of work:** The contractor will provide Technical Operational Support to the ILS-S Program by delivering agile and flexible IT services for the LogIT system, including its consolidation, integration, and sustainment.
- **Anticipated Acquisition Strategy and Dollar Value:** Small Business Enterprise Applications Solutions (SBEAS); \$10M - \$50M
- **Anticipated Contact Need Date:** 24 Feb 27
- **Anticipated Priorities/Considerations:** SCS Modernization timeline

# Medical Systems Product Line (MSPL)



## ■ Description of Program/Current State:

- **Air Force Medical Omnibus Web Application Pool (AFMOWAP)** tracks and manage waivers, personnel physical examinations, & manage non-weaponized radioactive materials.
  - 3 Applications – Aeromedical Information Management Information System (AIMWTS), Radioactive Materials Management Information System (RAMMIS), and Physical Examination Processing program (PEPP) - 3600 Active users (AFMEDCOM/SG)
  - **Medical Readiness Decision Support System (MRDSS)** is a system that enables the USAF medical community to monitor personnel, training, and equipment readiness while providing global visibility of wartime materiel and personnel to support fully ready deployment packages with approximately 5,500 active users.
- **Tool Utilized:** BES Atlassian Tools Suite, Checkmarx/Fortify, SonarQube, Dependency Tracker and, Selenium
- **Current/Anticipated Scope of work:** The contractor must provide all resources for agile program management, secure software development, robust automated testing, DevSecOps Engineering, and technical documentation.
- **Anticipated Acquisition Strategy and Dollar Value:** GSA Stars III Small Business 8(a) Competitive, ~\$15M - \$20M
- **Anticipated Contact Need Date:** 1 March 2027
- **Anticipated Priorities/Considerations:** Salesforce Migration, Technical Debt Reduction, Program Automation, Code Quality, Interface Management

# GB Cloud Acceleration Services (GBCAS)



- **Description of Program/Current State:** Continue moving selected business systems from legacy hosting environments to the procured cloud framework.
- **Current/Anticipated Scope of work:** Provide a pool of skilled resources for Cloud Assessment on legacy systems, Cloud Migration, Continuous Integration/Continuous Development and Cyber Security. Provide support services to BES programs utilizing tools such as Cloud One, AWS GovCloud services, Azure Government tools and DISA-approved vulnerability management .
- **Anticipated Acquisition Strategy and Dollar Value:** FAR 19.8 Small Business Competitive 8(a); ~ \$80M - \$90M
- **Anticipated Contact Need Date:** ~ 27 Nov 2026
- **Anticipated Priorities/Considerations:** Meet SAF/CN migration guidance memo for DAF enterprise cloud migration services. Goal is to migrate required PEO BES legacy system(s) to the cloud by 2028
