Overview

- Specializes in management of FAA-certified, commercial-derivative aircraft
- Supported missions include:
 - Presidential Airlift VC-25A
 - Survivable NMCS Node E-4B
 - Diplomatic, VIP, and DV Travel C-32, C-40, C-37, C-21, C-12
 - Multiple additional via FMS

Whats Next? (18-24 Months)

- C-32/C-40 CLS Follow-on Competition
 - RFP released Mar 2022; Proposals due Jun 2022
 - Contract Award ECD Mar 2023; Full performance ECD Jul 2023
- C-37 CLS Follow-on Competition
 - RFP release ECD Dec 2023; Proposals due Feb 2024
 - Contract Award ECD Nov 2024; Full performance ECD Feb 2025

<u>Overview</u>

- Executing \$3.9B contract to develop, test, certify, and deliver two VC-25Bs
- Providing flying White House with equivalent comms and security, enabling POTUS to execute all constitutional roles while airborne
- Integrating mission equipment into FAA-certified commercial aircraft (747-8)
- Major modification milestones:
 - Initiated modification on Aircraft #2 Jun 20
 - Awarded Initial Training Phase 1 contract mod Sep 20
 - Awarded Peculiar Support Equip contract mod Dec 20
 - Completed Decrib on Aircraft #1 Mar 21

Whats Next? (18-24 Months)

- Continued modification work; and developmental flight test
- Continued initial product support contracts (spares, support equipment, and training)







Overview



- Acquisition program to recapitalize E-4Bs, supporting these primary missions:
 - National Military Command System (NMCS)
 - Global Command and Control Mission (GC2M) in support of SECDEF
 - Continuity of Operations/Continuity of Government (COOP/COG)
 - Defense Support of Civil Authorities (DCSA)
- Progressing with acquisition planning; targeting competitive contract award in CY2023

- Draft EMD RFP Release end of Jun 2022
- Final EMD RFP Release Sep 2022
- Projected Contract Award late CY2023

- Teamed with leading companies developing supersonic or hypersonic capable aircraft, through SBIR and/or STRATFI funding
 - Technologies could provide future options for multiple USAF mission areas
 - Potential future high-speed passenger transport to support executive airlift

- BOOM XB-1 supersonic flight initiation Aug 22
- Hermeus MVP 0.1 First Flight (subsonic) Aug 22
- BOOM supersonic propulsion market assessment complete Jan 23
- BOOM Overture loop 2 wind tunnel test initiation Apr 23
- Hermeus MVP 1.0 Roll Out (hypersonic) May 23
